We are going to Manatee Lagoon. We will learn about manatees.


There will be a little bit of a walk to the building after we park.

We will interact with the seagrass wall.








We will interact with different educational screens.

We can make a pledge to help protect manatees.








We can look at the water from the upstairs observation deck.
